Even during the toughest time of their lives, while some weren't able to speak, there were others who speak for them; because with the meaning of empowerment comes the backing support of helping each other out.



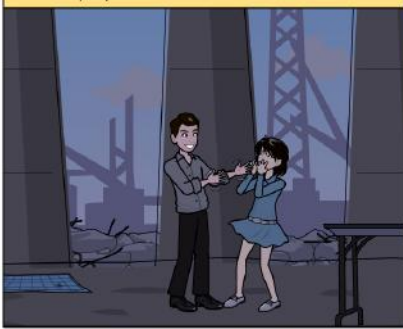
Of course, things didn't come easily, there were protests and fights for equality in order to allow us to have access to even greater things in our current day to day life.



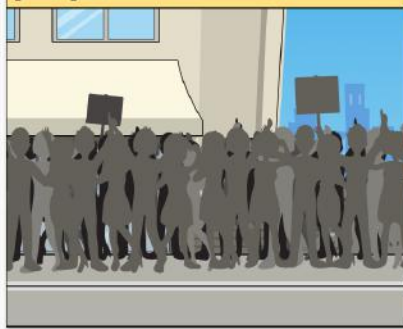
But, even with the concept of equality and the established rule we have in order to empower women, some still struggle on the inside.

We will continue to be each other's roots and wings, regardless of our time period and place.



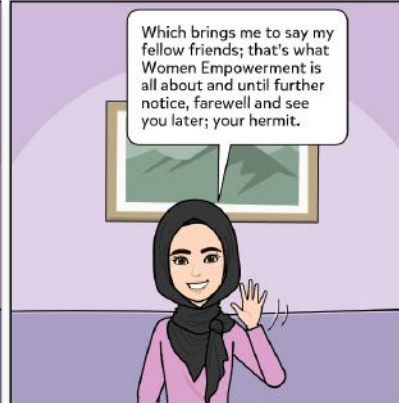
We will aspire to be much more than what we have become and continue to grow not only as a community, generation or people but as women.
